The third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday, expresses the joyful anticipation we all feel in awaiting the Christ. This week's readings are about joy and praising God. Gaudete itself means to rejoice. It a command, not an invitation. We are told to rejoice, that's what we are meant to do.

The job of angels is to worship and praise God, amongst other roles. Angels are constantly worshipping and praising their creator God. They are face to face with God and their joy is uncontainable. Angels model for us the joy that comes from worshipping God and praising Him.

What does it mean to praise God and worship Him? How do you do this, authentically, immersing your whole self into the experience? Carve out 15 minutes this week to praise God and worship Him through song or spoken prayer. Set aside control and enter wholly into the moment.
