Welcome home to St. Paul's Parish

St. Paul's is home to 2400 families who are registered as members. Our priests celebrate five weekend masses along with daily mass. We have two different properties that are bustling with activities daily and need to be maintained.

We are home to over twenty different ministry groups in four different languages. We are home to St. Paul's school with over 140 students.

We need each and every member to make our parish vibrant by sharing our gifts and talents to be the hands and feet of God to our Parish community. Gift of ADMINISTRATION empowers a Christian to be an effective channel of God's wisdom by providing the planning and coordination needed to accomplish good things.
ex: office assistance, Mass coordinator, bulk mailings, bulletin stuffing

Gift of CRAFTSMANSHIP empowers a Christian to be an effective channel of God's goodness to others through artistic or creative work that beautifies and/or orders the physical world.
ex: prayer shawls, building maintenance, decorating of the church

Gift of EVANGELISM empowers a Christian to be an effective channel of God's love by sharing the faith with others in a way that draws them to become disciples of Jesus and responsible members of his Church. ex: Youth ministry, Lector, Eucharistic Minister, Communion to the sick

Gift of MUSIC empowers a Christian to be a channel of God's creative goodness to others through writing or performing music for the delight of others and the praise of God.
ex: choir, liturgical music, prayer services, funerals, retreats & events

Gift of TEACHING empowers a Christian to be a channel of God's truth and wisdom by enabling others to learn information and skills that help them reach their fullest spiritual and personal potential.
ex: Religious Education, RCIA, School volunteer

Gift of HOSPITALITY empowers a Christian to be a generous channel of God's love by warmly welcoming and caring for those in need of food, shelter, and friendship. ex: welcomer, greeter, usher, funeral dinner

Gift of INTERCESSORY PRAYER empowers the intense prayer of a Christian for others to be the means by which God's love and deliverance reaches those in need. ex: small prayer groups, Adoration, Divine Mercy prayer group

Gift of MERCY empowers a Christian to be a channel of God's love through practical deeds of compassion that relieve the distress of those who suffer and help them experience God's love ex: St. Vincent's, Prison ministry
